Graduating high school seniors attending any two - or four-year college are encouraged to apply for one of five \$1,000 Ag Youth Scholarships.



Student Eligibility

- High school senior, graduating in the spring
- Legal U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- · Majoring in or planning to major in an agriculture related field
- The student, parent or grandparent of the student must be a patron member of Nexus Cooperative

Application Checklist

Complete application
Official school transcripts
Two letters of recommendation
Acceptance letter from selected two- or four-year college (if applicable)
Complete responses to all questions and essays
Academic verification complete with signature by a school administrator/guidance counselor
Applicant and parent/quardian signature, if applicant is under 18 years

Selection Process

Nexus Ag Youth Scholarship recipients shall be determined by an internal committee. Selection will be made on the basis of scholarship ability and citizenship qualities.

All materials (see checklist) must be postmarked by March 15. All applicants will receive formal notification at their Senior Awards event and/or by mail shortly after.
